Elizabeth Jett, MD

Dr. Elizabeth A. Jett grew up in Oklahoma City. Her interest in breast imaging began as an undergraduate in the biomedical engineering department at Duke University

where she studied acoustic streaming in cystic lesions of the breast. During the summer of 1996, she was the first honors research fellow at the OU Breast Institute, studying prevention of rat mammary carcinoma utilizing leuprolide as an equivalent to oophorectomy. She completed her MD at the University of Oklahoma in 1999.

Dr. Jett did her radiology training at the University of California San Diego. After completing a fellowship in mammography and cardiothoracic imaging, she joined the faculty at USC. In 2006, she returned home to Oklahoma with a faculty appointment at the OU Breast Institute and the department of radiology.

Rebecca Stough, MD

Dr. Rebecca G. Stough is a native of Tulsa. She graduated from the University of Oklahoma, then received her MD from the OU College of Medicine in 1975. She was one of only 10 women in her medical class.

She completed her residency at OU Health Sciences Center in the Department of Radiology. She was Chief Resident in her 4th year. She stayed on staff for 2 years.

In 1981, she opened the first outpatient CT scanner in Oklahoma and only the second one in the nation. In 1992, she joined Radiology Consultants at Mercy Health Center and in 1999 became the Director of Imaging for the Mercy Women's Center.

She started the first Comprehensive Breast MRI program in Oklahoma in March 2003 and is currently Director of Imaging for Breast MRI of Oklahoma, LLC.

At the end of this presentation, participants will:

1. Determine the value of screening mammograms.
2. Know the difference between screening mammograms and diagnostic.
3. Know the different types of breast biopsies.
4. Determine the indications for different modalities, including x-ray, ultrasound and MRI.
